

# Where do I go and what happens when I . . .

## Report to Law Enforcement

### Where can I go

- SIU Department of Public Safety (SIU Police)
- Local law enforcement (Carbondale Police, Jackson County Sherriff's Office, Illinois State Police, etc)

### What can I expect

If it's an emergency call 911, police can provide protection and initiate a criminal investigation

If police are called and you are not ready to file a report for criminal charges police can initiate an informational report and explain what happens when a criminal report is completed.

You can meet with an officer at the police department or a place of your choosing. A support person of your choice can come with you to make a police report.

## Report to the University

### Where can I go

- Office of Diversity and Equity – Davies Hall, Room 150
- Title IX Coordinator, Anthony Hall, Room 110
- SIU Employees and Campus Security Authorities

### What can I expect

Meeting with staff at the Office of Diversity and Equity or the Title IX Coordinator will initiate a University investigation, provide resources, and begin interim protective measure.

Campus Security Authorities of other university employee will submit an SIU Campus Crime Report and staff from the Office of Diversity and Equity will contact you.

Staff will explain the investigation and adjudication process. A support person of your choice can come with you to make the report.

## Seek Confidential Support

### Where can I go

- Staff at the Student Health Center Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS)
- Staff at the Student Health Center Medical Clinic

### What can I expect

Any information, oral or written, given to a counselor will be kept confidential, including the fact that you are receiving services. No one, inside or outside the university, will be told that you are a client here.

CAPS offers group counseling, individual counseling, and couples counseling, crisis services and behavior therapy.

Counselor in Residence is a new program offering counseling services with the residence halls. Staff is located in Grinnell Hall, Room 106.

## Pursue Protective/ Court Orders

### Where can I go

- SIU Department of Public Safety and Local law enforcement
- Student Rights and Responsibilities
- Carbondale Women's Center
- Jackson County State's Attorney

### What can I expect

Staff can assist you by talking about protective orders for sexual assaults, dating violence, domestic violence, stalking and harassment.

The university may impose a temporary "No Contact" order restricting contact between individuals during the course of an Investigation.

A support person of your choice can come with you to meet these individuals.
